Specifically, the association's objectives are:

- (a) Collecting, exploiting, exchanging and transferring information, experience and knowledge relating to the organisation, administration, financial management and other issues of the water and sewerage sector.
- (b) Concentrating, disseminating knowledge, know-how, experience and information relating to technology and other innovative issues.
- (c) Studying financial issues of common interest to the boards and submitting proposals in dealing with these issues.
- (d) Contributing to the boards efforts to establish a legal framework relating to the social and environmental sectors.
- (e) Organising joint training programs for executives and staff of all members.
- (f) Promoting joint actions to address issues of common interest.
- (g) Participating in various bodies established for the planning and implementation of water supply and sewerage projects, contributing in the effective management of the available funds and resources.

(h) Monitoring the evolution and latest developments in water and sewerage related issues, internationally and especially within the European Union.

(i) In general, promoting common policies, practices, and objectives within the area of the association members' responsibilities and duties.

Members of the association are all the legally established water boards and the urban sewerage boards of the country (Nicosia, Limassol, Larnaka, Paphos, Famagusta, Ayia Napa and Paralimni).
